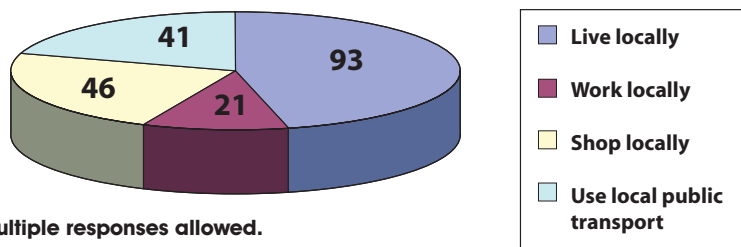
Over 11,000 people asked to give their views...

In July we invited over 11,000 residents, groups and businesses to attend our two day exhibition which took place on Friday 13 and Saturday 14 July in an exhibition trailer outside Seven Sisters Tube Station.

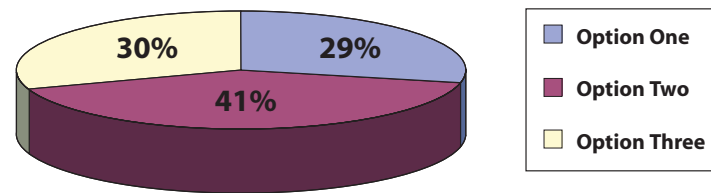
During the two days over 350 people visited the exhibition and viewed our proposals for Wards Corner.

As well as informing local people of our ideas it was vital we received their feedback on our proposals for the area. We asked people to complete a feedback questionnaire, which they were able to leave at the exhibition, send back using our freepost address or complete online at www.wardscornerregeneration.co.uk. We have now received 104 responses and below is a breakdown of the results.

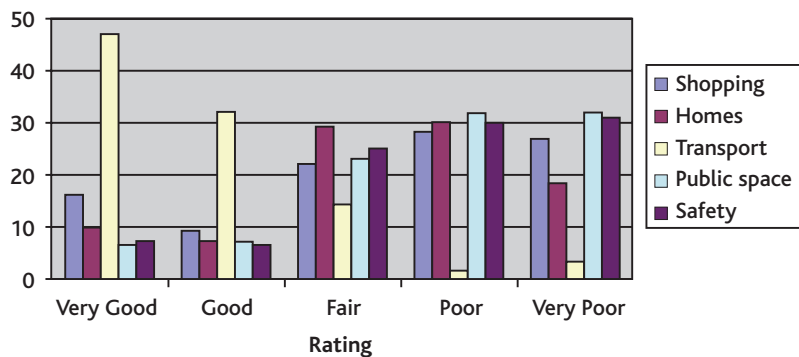
Q: Do you live / work / shop locally or use local public transport?



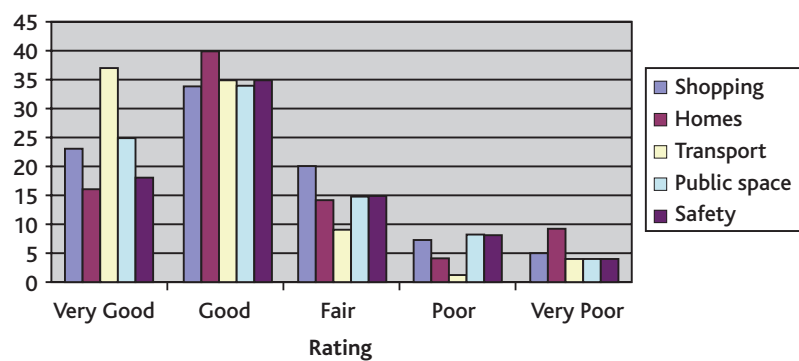
Q: What is your opinion of the options for the public space?
